

ADDED AUTHORIZATION & Certificate Program in AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDERS

FALL COURSES NOW OPEN FOR REGISTRATION!

Cal Poly Pomona's online Autism Authorization/Certificate program is offered through the College of the Extended University (CEU) and open to anyone interested in learning more about autism. University admission is not required to register for or complete courses. All students must register through the [College of the Extended University](http://www.ceu.csupomona.edu) (Phone: 909-869-2288; www.ceu.csupomona.edu). The fee for each course is \$695.

There are three required courses, all of which are graduate-level courses and offered online only. Each course requires 5 hours of fieldwork with students with autism disorders. Upon completion of all courses, students will earn a Certificate of Completion. Those eligible for the Added Authorization (see below) may apply through Cal Poly's Credential Services Office. The Added Authorization in ASD is required by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing for teachers who (1) work with students with autism spectrum disorders; and (2) have one of the following credentials:

- i. Level I or Level II Mild/Moderate credential
- ii. Level I or Level II Deaf and Hard of Hearing credential
- iii. Level I or Level II Visual Impairments credential
- iv. Level I or Level II Physical and Health Impairments credential
- v. Old Learning Handicapped (LH), Physical Handicaps (PH), Communication Handicaps (CH), Visual Handicaps (VH) credentials (Ryan)
