Policy: SELPA Monitoring Responsibilities

(BP 2006)

Each SELPA in California is responsible for submitting a SELPA Local Plan to the California Superintendent of Public Instruction via submission to the California Department of Education (“CDE”). One of the components of that Local Plan shall include monitoring of member local educational agencies to assist the CDE in ensuring that member LEAs are in compliance with state and federal special education laws as well as monitoring the appropriate use of federal, state, and local funds allocated for special education programs.
