Policy: Uniform Complaint Procedures

(BP 2007)

The SELPA JPA Board recognizes that the SELPA has the responsibility to ensure compliance with applicable state and federal laws and regulations governing special education programs. The SELPA JPA Board encourages the early resolution of complaints whenever possible. To resolve complaints which may require a more formal process, the SELPA JPA Board adopts the uniform system of complaint processes specified in California law to the extent that it applies to the Santa Barbara County SELPA.
